Pierson-Brown's work outside the studio is equally impressive, as she is an active member of the Pittsburgh architecture community. Pierson-Brown is a co-founder and leader of Women+ in Design PGH, board member of AIA Pittsburgh, and adjunct studio instructor at the University of Pittsburgh architecture studios.
